- (iii) Submit **Form IEPF-5** for claiming unpaid amounts/shares.
- (iv) Send the **hard copy of Form IEPF-5**, its challan, and original supporting documents to the Company's RTA

We strongly urge all shareholders to take prompt action during this campaign period to safeguard their entitlements and ensure compliance with statutory requirements.
